MAJOR SOLO SHOW AT ORA-ORA BY RENOWNED ARTIST FERNANDO BOTERO: LIVING WITH BOTERO

HONG KONG – September 14, 2021 Ora-Ora is pleased to announce a landmark exhibition at its new **Tai Kwun** gallery space, a blockbuster solo show by renowned Colombian artist **Fernando Botero**. *Living with Botero* is Ora-Ora's major autumn show, and will open October 6 – November 27. The gallery will be styled as a **recreation of the artist's apartment in New York**, allowing visitors the privilege of stepping into the everyday life of Fernando Botero. The exhibition will present a way of life, a unique combination of passion, serenity and community. It is an open invitation to everyone, one of immersion and interactivity, as visitors enter the familiar surroundings of the artist at work. It will comprise paintings and drawings neverbefore-seen in Hong Kong, most of which the artist lived with and counted among his personal favourites.

Highlights of the exhibition will include the artist's dialogue with Vincent van Gogh, entitled *Sunflowers* (oil on canvas, 1977) and his enormous 191cm x 127.5cm painting, *Woman in the Bathroom* (oil on canvas, 2002). His unique, voluptuous interpretation of van Gogh's legendary still life references Botero's



belief that "For an artist, the quality of the art you create, is a function of who you admire." **Woman in the Bathroom** is the artist at full throttle, the heady, vibrant colour palette, paired with the loving, tender portrayal of size and volume. Its subject is both coy and red-blooded, both protagonist and startled reactionary, a festival of wavy lines and curved vivacity. Here is a sense of mischief and life at its most animated and ebullient, the painting turned up to a higher decibel than everyday life as we may know it. This is one of many paintings on display which were previously hung in the artist's home (**Woman in the Bathroom hung in his New York apartment**); other examples include **Snake** (from Botero's Bogota home, oil on canvas, 1979).

Additionally, a range of **Botero-themed collectibles** have been designed specifically for this show, and will be on sale at the gallery throughout the exhibition period. Running alongside will be a number of tailored events, specially created by Ora-Ora in consultation with the artist and his family. More details to follow.

At 89 years old, Fernando Botero is one of the world's most celebrated and influential artists. He has been a major force in world art for several decades, with a unique style which has become known as *boterismo*. Having first come to global attention in the 1950s, Botero has been a witness to major art movements but quickly developed a signature style which is only his own. From apples to mandolins, from Verdi to Picasso, bullfighting to Abu Ghraib, Botero's influences and inspirations are varied and resistant to classification. And yet his passion for portraying truths about Colombia and South America show him to be an artist who has never lost sight of his home, his roots and his essence. Perhaps this partly accounts for his great popularity.



This much anticipated solo show brings four decades of Botero's work to Hong Kong, as Ora-Ora brings this global phenomenon to a new audience. In so doing, Ora-Ora resumes the dialogue which was so memorably established by the acclaimed China exhibitions at the National Museum of China in Beijing in 2015 and the China Art Museum of Shanghai in 2016. Although the pandemic has prevented the artist from travelling to attend the exhibition, it has been a personal ambition of Fernando Botero to present these works in Hong Kong, and he has spoken recently of the special place that Hong Kong has in his heart.

This exhibition brings visitors a new sense of intimacy with an artist who has never shied away from a fight. It also seeks to bring calm in difficult times. Visitors are invited to call their own troubles, struggles and obstacles to mind when they contemplate the exhibition. How to describe the life of this artistic luminary who emerged from poverty in his beloved Colombia to occupy a global stage? A life of adventure certainly. He spent two years at a bullfighting school, was once expelled from high school for his staunch defence of Picasso, he protested injustices at times of war, and yet brought the bright warmth of South America to the world. Those who seek satire, retribution and anger at the world's calumnies will find a spirited fellow activist, and those who long for peace and tranquillity will find those havens in Botero.

Ora-Ora co-founder Henrietta Tsui-Leung invites you to come and see the show: "Fernando Botero's wish for us is that the people of Hong Kong will come to this exhibition and embrace the connection he feels to this city. To see Botero's art is a privilege, but *Living with Botero* is a privilege that everyone can be a part of. It brings a message of hope, community and fellowship."

The exhibition will open at Ora-Ora's new premises in renowned Hong Kong arts and heritage hub, Tai Kwun. This landmark redevelopment in the centre of Hong Kong dates from the 19th century and has been at the heart of Hong Kong civic life since its inception. Its repurposing as a leading venue for the arts and cultural life made it a compelling choice for Ora-Ora as it sought larger premises. Following Ora-Ora's current solo show by Chinese artist, Zhang Yanzi, entitled *Where the Heart Is, Living with Botero* will showcase the flexibility of a space which will re-imagine Botero's living quarters.

Living with Botero underscores the capabilities of Ora-Ora's art advisory practice. With more than 15 years of experience in artist management and development, Ora-Ora's extensive knowledge is regularly deployed to benefit its clients, assisting and supporting both new and established collectors. About Fernando Botero

Fernando Botero was born in Medellin, Colombia in 1932. Globally renowned for his unique handling of volume, shape and colour, Botero is an artist of both popularity and critical acclaim. Having spent two years at a specialist school for matadors in Colombia as a child, Botero always maintained a fascination for the sport, and for the theatre and traditions of his native land. Deriving broad and exuberant inspiration from such diverse sources as clowns, the corrida and Piero De la Francesca, Botero has been a major force in art since the 1950s. The artist first showed at the Guggenheim in New York in 1958, the same year he provided illustrations for a novel by his friend, Gabriel Garcia Marquez. In 1963, the artist presented his *Mona Lisa*, *Age 12* at New York's MoMA, a counterpoint to the *Mona Lisa* which was being shown at the Metropolitan Museum of Art. Later works were to draw on influences of Albrecht Dürer and Edouard Manet among others. Attracted to forms and mass, yet with a passionate love for the sunshine, history and contradictions of his homeland, Botero's style of *boterismo* is unmistakeable. The artist now divides his time between Paris, France, New York, and Tuscany. Botero was twice included in the Venice Biennale, in 1958 and 1992. His works are in the collections of The Museum of Modern Art in New York, the Art Institute of Chicago, and the museum dedicated to him, the Museo Botero in Bogotá.

關於費爾南多·博特羅(Fernando Botero)

費爾南多·博特羅,1932年出生於哥倫比亞麥德林。博特羅以其對體積、形狀和顏色的獨特處理而享譽全球,是一位廣受歡迎和評論界讚譽的藝術家。博特羅小時候曾在哥倫比亞的一所鬥牛士專門學校待過兩年,他一直迷戀鬥牛、戲劇和他祖國的文化傳統。自20世紀50年代以來,博特羅一直是藝術領域的中流砥柱,他從小丑、鬥牛和皮耶羅·德拉·弗朗切斯卡(Piero della Francesca)等多種途徑汲取廣泛而豐富的靈感。1958年,這位藝術家首次在紐約古根漢博物館(Guggenheim)展出。同年,他為朋友加夫列爾·加西亞·馬爾克斯(Gabriel Garcia Marquez)的小說繪製了插圖。1963年,這位藝術家在紐約現代藝術博物館(MoMA)展出了他12歲時所作的《蒙娜麗莎》(Mona Lisa),與正在大都會藝術博物館(Metropolitan Museum of Art)展出的《蒙娜麗莎》形成對比。博特羅後來的作品受到阿爾布雷希特·杜勒(Albrecht Dürer)和愛德華·馬奈(Edouard Manet)等人的影響。他被形式和團塊所吸引,對家鄉的陽光、歷史和複雜性充滿了熱愛,具備非常明顯的「博特羅主義」。這位藝術家現在在巴黎、法國、紐約和托斯卡納多地生活。博特羅曾於1958年和1992年兩次入選威尼斯雙年展。他的作品被紐約現代藝術博物館、芝加哥藝術學院(the Art Institute of Chicago)和專為他而設的博特羅博物館(the Museo Botero in Boqotá)收藏。

费尔南多·博特罗,1932 年出生於哥伦比亚麦德林。博特罗以其对体积、形状和颜色的独特处理而享誉全球,是一位广受欢迎和评论界赞誉的艺术家。博特罗小时候曾在哥伦比亚的一所斗牛士专门学校待过两年,他一直迷恋斗牛、戏剧和他祖国的文化传统。自 20 世纪 50 年代以来,博特罗一直是艺术领域的中流砥柱,他从小丑、斗牛和皮耶罗·德拉·弗朗切斯卡(Piero della Francesca)等多种途径汲取广泛而丰富的灵感。1958 年,这位艺术家首次在纽约古根汉博物馆(Guggenheim)展出。同年,他为朋友加夫列尔·加西亚·马尔克斯(Gabriel Garcia Marquez)的小说绘制了插图。1963 年,这位艺术家在纽约现代艺术博物馆(MoMA)展出了他12岁时所作的《蒙娜丽莎》(Mona Lisa),与正在大都会艺术博物馆(Metropolitan Museum of Art)展出的《蒙娜丽莎》形成对比。博特罗后来的作品受到阿尔布雷希特·杜勒(Albrecht Dürer)和爱德华·马奈(Edouard Manet)等人的影响。他被形式和团块所吸引,对家乡的阳光、历史和复杂性充满了热爱,具备非常明显的"博特罗主义"。这位艺术家现在在巴黎、法国、纽约和托斯卡纳多地生活。博特罗曾於 1958 年和 1992 年两次入选威尼斯双年展。他的作品被纽约现代艺术博物馆、芝加哥艺术学院(the Art Institute of Chicago)和专为他而设的博特罗博物馆(the Museo Botero in Bogotá)收藏。
